OVERALL AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY

Operational Management Actions - Page 50

- 7.2.1.1 Continue & Enhance Pest Plant and Animal control programs.

- 7.7.3 Change main access to Park Roadworks - internal and external at Riverview.

- 7.2.4.1 Establish and implement an on-going vegetation program aimed at long term replacement of exotic species.

- 7.2.7.1 Undertake pest animal control works associated with Hooded Plover habitat.

Capital Works Actions - Page 48

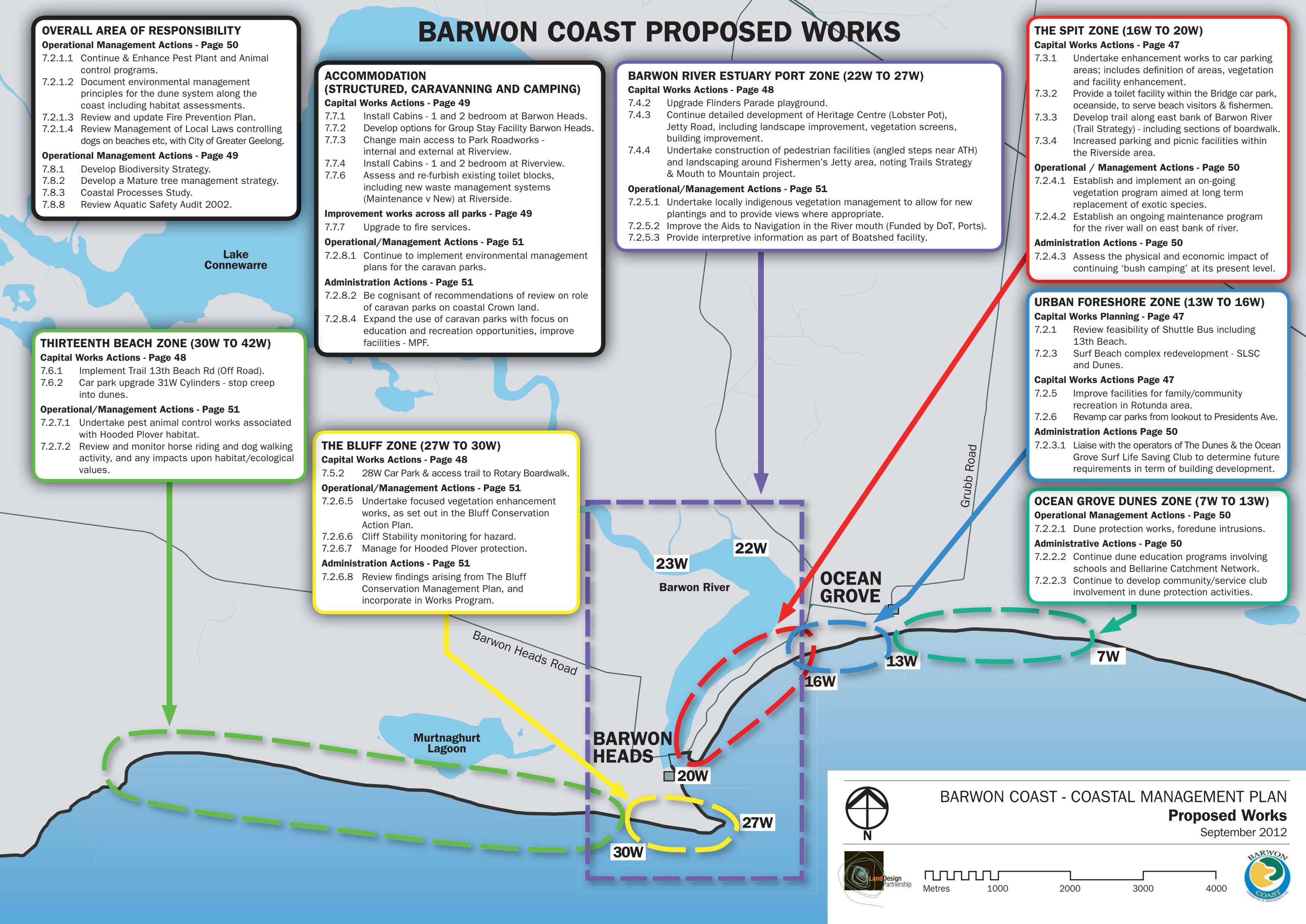
- 7.5.2 28W Car Park & access trail to Rotary Boardwalk.
