Every person walking past the area reduces the time they have to feed near the water.

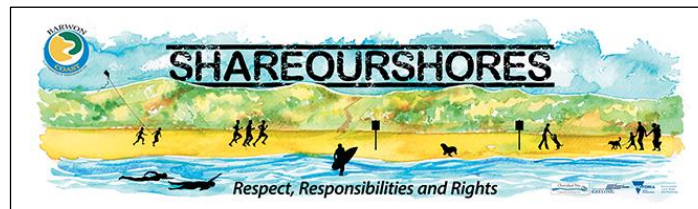
For the time being please use the steps outside of the roped area and walk along the track to the next steps before returning to the beach.
