Off leash under effective control means your dog:

- Must come back when called;
- Does not interact with other people or dogs unless invited:
- Does not approach wildlife.

All leads including retractable
must be restricted to 2 metres in
length when encountering other
people, wildlife, cyclists or dogs.

Seals and other wildlife see dogs as predators.

Controls for Dogs on Beaches

No dogs or people in the dunes

All other places dogs on leash



DOG CONTROL ZONE GUIDELINES

Area A (40W to 36W)

- Dogs must be on leash when horses are present. Dogs permitted off leash under effective control other times.

Area B (36W to 34W) and Area C (27W to 15W west)

- Dogs on leash from 1 December to 30 April from 7:00pm to 9:00am and prohibited from 9:00am to 7:00pm.
- Dogs permitted off leash under effective control from 1 May to 30 November.

Area D (15W west to 13W) - Ocean Grove Main Beach

These orders are being trialled for 12 months: Prohibited all year.

Area E (8W to 7W)

- Dogs on leash 75 metres either side of the 7W access point.
