Our Draft Coastal and Marine Management Plan (CMMP) 2020-2025 is open for comment on www.engage.vic.gov.au until the 10th of January 2020. This plan describes a long-term vision for the Barwon coastline that reflects community aspirations and policy directions for marine and coastal management.

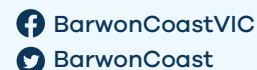
JETTY JUMPING
